- Tables can be decorated by displaying a setting that celebrates the community and promotes your organization/family/small business.

Important Dates

- The First Annual Tablescapes Exhibit “Celebrating Our Community” opening party will be held **WEDNESDAY, June 3rd, 2026**. Kankakee County Historical Society members and their guests enjoy a night of kicking off the summer season at the museum. **Your organization will receive ONE free ticket** with the option to purchase additional tickets. Names of ticket holders need to be provided to the museum no later than May 22nd). Hours are 5 – 7 pm (open house style setting with appetizers and soft drinks included with ticket). **Tickets must be paid in advance. No tickets will be sold at the door.**
- The 2026 Tablescapes Exhibit will open to the public **Thursday, June 4th, 2026**.
- **The museum's hours during the month of June are Thursday – Saturday 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.** The museum will have **SPECIAL HOURS** on Sunday, June 21st (9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.), to celebrate Kankakee Day. The museum will also be hosting our first bi-annual **“Night at the Musuem”** on Saturday, June 20th, during which hundreds of community members are expected to walk through the exhibit space.
- The last day the 2026 Tablescapes Exhibit will be open to the public is **June 27th, 2026** (Saturday). All votes will be counted at the end of that day.
- **The museum staff will decide the final placement for each organization's display for the perfect fit.**
- **Tables may be decorated between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on May 28th, 29th, and 30th**
- **Tablescape decorations are to be removed between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. June 28th, 2026 (Sunday).** *Special accommodation must be arranged in advance.

Decorating Guidelines

- A 30-inch round table will be provided to you. The table must stay in its original location. You must supply your own set up: tablecloth, dining sets, décor, etc. **No candles or organic material are permitted including dirt, hay, straw, food, or live foliage (Ex: NO REAL FLOWERS).**
- **Decorations are limited to the actual table provided.**
- The museum cannot be responsible for lost or broken dining sets, or other materials associated with your table or display area.
- The Museum will provide signage that will be placed on your table.

- Please, be mindful that many people will be viewing your tablescape.

Fees

- All participating organizations/businesses/families are asked to donate a single item for a raffle basket! Items can relate to your business/organization or tablescape theme.
- \$30 donation due prior to May 22, 2026. **Fees are non-refundable.**

- Voting will be in four categories: **Non-profits, Small Businesses, Families & OVERALL**.
- First Place in each category: **Non-profits, Small Businesses, Families** will receive:
 - Free entry into next year's (2027) Tablescapes Exhibit
- The top three **OVERALL** prizes will be:
