

Mrs. Evelyn Hurst, Former Resident Dies In California

Mrs. Evelyn McKinstry Hurst, 56, former Kankakee resident, died Wednesday in Long Beach, Calif. Death followed a short illness.

Funeral services and burial will be in Los Angeles.

Mrs. Hurst was born in Kankakee, reared here and was graduated from Kankakee High School in 1924. She was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. David S. McKinstry. Her mother was a sister of the late Gov. Len Small.

Upon the death of Mr. McKinstry, who supervised the state farms in Illinois during Gov. Small's administration, the family moved in 1925 to the state of Washington where they resided on the Ribbon Cliff Ranch. Later they moved to California.

Mrs. McKinstry died in 1947.

Surviving are sons, William and Richard Hunter, both of California; a brother, Bruce McKinstry of Riverside, and sisters, Mrs. J. Klamm of Seattle, Wash., and Miss Jean McKinstry of Bremerton, Wash.
